District Policy

The Custodian of Records may set the time during normal office hours and the place for records to be inspected and require that the Custodian of Records or a delegated employee be present while the records are examined. Pursuant to CORA, all records must be made available for inspection within three working days, unless extenuating circumstances exist. The deadline may be extended by seven working days if extenuating circumstances exist and the requesting party is notified of the delay within the statutory period.

A person granted the right to inspect District records will also be furnished copies requested, up to ten standard pages at no charge, with any amount over ten standard pages at a cost of \$0.25 per standard page. The charge for providing a copy, printout or photograph of a public record in a format other than a standard page will be assessed at the actual cost of production. Additionally, documents must be retrieved, sorted or reviewed for applicability to the request, and such process requires one or more hours of staff time, the District may charge a reasonable research and retrieval fee of \$30.00 per hour after the first hour, which will be free of charge. (C.R.S. 24-72-205(6)(a)) effective July 1, 2014.
